## Ipai-Reha

Fully adjustable special needs car seat, offering excellent posture support options and a backrest recline feature.

- Ensure the **Ipai-Reha's back is flush with the cars seat back** or **headrest** if this is non removable (no big gaps).
- There is no tether for this seat, but ensure the clamp bow is slotted correctly between the seat and backrest of the car, OR that the ISOFIX/LATCH connectors are correctly in use.
- Ensure child **has not outgrown the weight capacity which is 36kg**. If child is approaching this weight limit, consider what car seat would be next option.
- This seat has the capability to be very easily grown in back height and seat length. If you are raising the headrest height, please ensure you are also bringing up the shoulder strap height to the appropriate level using a 8mm spanner. If you are unsure please contact your Occupational Therapy team.
- Ensure the car's seatbelt is used EVERY time. This is to be securely fastened OVER the child and seat. Please note this seat does not have capacity to have a belt threaded through the back as it is a booster seat. You are able to purchase and install a padded sleeve for the seatbelt if you feel the belt is going to irritate your child.
- Please note the red belt guide above the shoulder is to be used to ensure the belt is sitting correctly, is kept low across the child's hips and is kept off the child's face. The lower portion of the belt is to be threaded through the belt guide spaces on either side of the child's thighs.
- Periodically check for loose or missing parts.
- Keep child's fingers clear of moving parts and swivel latches.
